DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Little Shop of Horrors is not a shy musical. Alan Menken has built for us an incredibly goofy world that is not afraid to wear its heart on its sleeve with an ensemble of characters so stuck in their places that they would give anything to stop stagnantly dreaming and leave their given situations. We as an audience are presented with sincerity and honesty, but the second we are comfortable, it is stripped away from us. Menken refuses to separate his performers from his audience; exactly the purpose of a good story.

Underneath all of these theatrical layers exists an internal world so close to ours it's a bit tough to shake. Regardless of the fact that we are all seated in a theatre in Michigan, Skid Row remains a very real place in the context of both our universe and the characters'. Despite the often cartoony and theatrical exaggeration present in this musical, the world built by Menken is still rooted in truth. Human greed overpowering all else is a story we have seen in our own history time and time again, and that theme does not halt within this venue's walls.

This little seed of reality is what makes *Little Shop of Horrors* so important and omnipresent. Parables and myths exist not because they are factual, but because they are real. These characters are props that carry the history of human greed and love within them — they are you and me and your great-grandfather and mine. It is my hope that this production is able to act as a mirror.


